### **Wayne County Health Department Offering Walk-in COVID-19 Vaccinations**

All residents 16 and older are now eligible to receive the vaccine. However, Pfizer is the only vaccine authorized for ages 16 and 17. Walk-ins and appointments will be available at the Wayne County Community College Downriver Campus (210000 Northline Road) on Wednesday, April 14 through Saturday, April 17 between the hours of 9am and 3pm at no cost.

Residents under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to receive the vaccine. Appointments can be scheduled by calling the Wayne County Health Department at 1-866-610-3885.
