Employers! Would you like to host a vaccine clinic for employees? Macomb County is working with local employers to make it easier than ever for employees who would like to be vaccinated. If you would like to learn more about hosting a clinic, [please complete this survey](#).

The Macomb County Health Department is now accepting COVID-19 vaccination appointments for anyone aged 12 and older. **IMPORTANT:** Only the Pfizer vaccine is approved for use for those aged 12 to 17. Individuals in this age range who wish to be vaccinated **MUST** select the Verkuilen Building in Clinton Township or the SW Center in Warren/Majestic Plaza when they make their appointment. All minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Same day, and Saturday appointments are now available at the Verkuilen Building in Clinton Township and the SW Center in Warren/Majestic Plaza. To make an appointment, go to [macombgov.org/covidvaccine](https://macombgov.org/covidvaccine).

Parents: Your child may have some common side effects like chills and a headache after getting vaccinated. These are normal signs that their body is building protection. These side effects might affect your child's ability to do daily activities, but they should go away after a few days. [Learn more](#) from the CDC.
