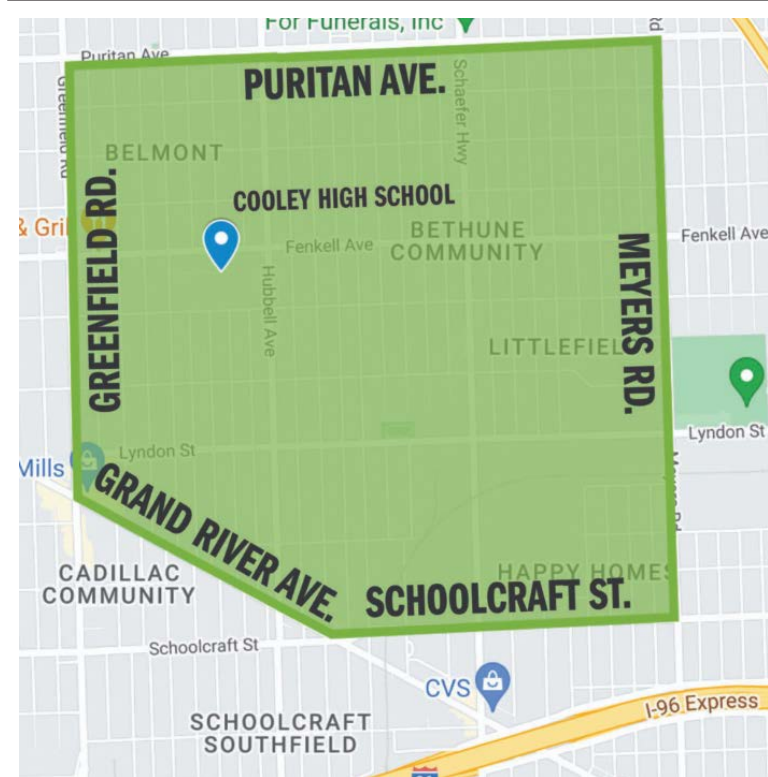




HIGH VOLUME / HIGH PURPOSE / HIGH IMPACT VOLUNTEERISM

2022 PROJECT DETAILS

- Volunteers will focus on mowing and trimming overgrown brush and weeds on vacant properties, as well as provide free lawn care and minor curb appeal upgrades for a limited number of Cooley community residents.
- All necessary tools will be provided by Life Remodeled, but volunteers can bring their own tools if they prefer.
- Volunteers should bring their own work gloves and protective eyewear/sunglasses. Water is provided, but we advise volunteers to bring extra water as well as snacks if needed.
- Volunteers will drive to the former Cooley High School (15055 Hubbell Ave, Detroit, MI 48227) then board shuttle buses that will transport them to Command Centers throughout the neighborhood.
- At the end of their shift, volunteers are bussed back to Cooley High School to participate in the after-party event and return to their vehicles.
- Every participant must sign a digital waiver and wear the volunteer shirt provided by Life Remodeled.



With substantial investments of cash, labor and materials, Life Remodeled focuses on the intentional and equitable revitalization of Detroit neighborhoods distinguished by their significant need and radical hope. Projects are determined by the community's needs and visions and we assist in three areas: renovating and repurposing former community assets into opportunity hubs, repairing owner-occupied homes, and annually mobilizing 10,000 volunteers in six days to beautify the four square miles surrounding our current opportunity hub.
